

## Ladybridge Primary School Half Termly Core Curriculum Plan 2023/24 – Spring 1 – Year 6

Unit to be covered	<u>Measurement</u> Children recognise, read and write all metric measures for length, mass and capacity. Understand conversions between metric measurements for capacity. The use of pictorial representations, such as bar models and number lines, to represent the problem helps children to choose the correct operation(s) to solve the problem. Explore imperial measures and the relationships between imperial and metric measures.		<u>Ratio</u> Children explore the fact that the relationship between two numbers can be expressed additively or multiplicatively. Children see how one value is related to another by making simple comparisons, such as: "For every 2 blue counters, there are 3 red counters." Children build on the ideas of the previous step to understand that the same ratio can be written in different forms, for example 4 : 6 can be written as 2 : 3. Children apply their understanding of ratio and multiplicative relationships through scale diagrams. Children need to know that one shape is an enlargement of another if all the matching sides are in the same ratio.
