

What specialist services and expertise are available at or accessed by the school?

At times it may be necessary to consult with outside agencies to receive more specialised expertise to help school as well as parents and carers to best support their child.

We have an allocated Educational Psychologist who can work with individual pupils who have significant additional need. The psychologist will provide advice to both parents and carers as well as the school once assessments and observations have been completed.
